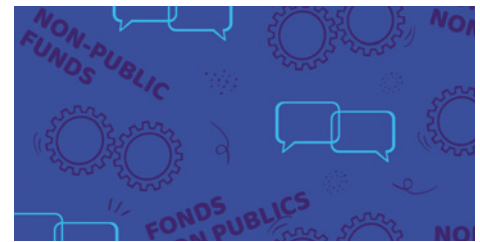


Joint Learning Program
