USJE's members are **regularly denied** Workers' Compensation by provincial/territorial boards for their occupational injuries.

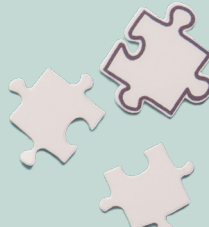
