2026 National Public Service Week

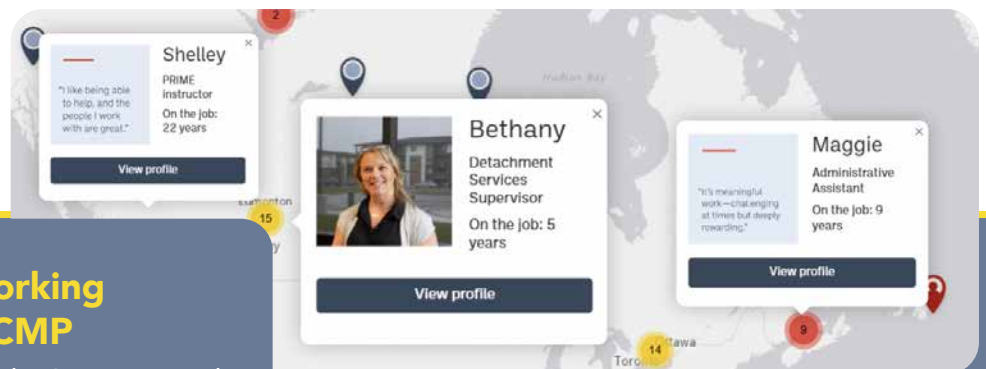

USJE pilot project supports communities across Canada
